My favorite part was when I taught the missions class in Tulelake and all the kids got to write letters and draw pictures to missionaries; telling of how we were praying for them. 3 Summer Missionaries helped at Alturas Baptist Church July 7<sup>th</sup> – 11<sup>th</sup> for their VBS and had almost 100 children and workers. There were 7 salvations!

2 Summer Missionaries assisted a 4 day youth camping trip in Greenville, CA. July 14<sup>th</sup> – 18<sup>th</sup>. There were about 30 campers and 4 salvations.



Bible Club in Stead, NV, July 14<sup>th</sup> -18<sup>th</sup> was amazing! The mission team from Beaumont, CA and 2 missionaries from FAITH averaged around 40 kids with puppet shows, live Bible stories and outstanding music!

**Camp Tehama 2014:** This year's Missions Camp was a blessing with 5 salvations, 7 rededications, 5 assurances of salvation, and 14 churches participating with 2 students going back to their church to be baptized!

The summer missionaries & workers from our sister churches did a great job of helping out with worship services, classes & general daily activities. Students learned how to present the Gospel in various ways, give testimonies, present dramas, team building, learn about missionaries & some even served in Chester on a Mission project. There were also fun activities like fishing, climbing wall, swimming, ultimate football, crafts, campfire & crazy camp songs!

We had 142 present with every cabin in use, so next year we're looking at a Youth Missions Camp (7<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> grades) and another week for Children's Missions Camp (3<sup>rd</sup>-6<sup>th</sup> grades). Please keep the students, workers & churches in prayer that they will continue to live the "Acts 1:8 Life" in their homes & communities!

## Area Missionary News

This summer has gone by quickly! We had 5 great Summer Missionaries helping our churches reach and teach children & youth.
