



## Mission of Equip Biblical Institute

Our mission is to bring glory to God by assisting local churches to equip believers of various cultures and languages to live and minister biblically based on the inerrant Word of God. This equipping includes building biblical knowledge, Christian character, and ministry skills. The vision is to provide EBI Church Planting and Leadership Training Centers at no charge to local churches and associations except the honorarium for the professor.

## Benefits of Learning through EBI

The goal is to equip church planters, pastors, and church leaders and members for effective servant ministry by making Bible college and seminary level courses available to local churches at a fraction of the cost of traditional schools. Each EBI Leadership Training Center is self-supporting. Graduates are eligible to participate in Southern California Seminary commencement. EBI students can apply up to 60 semester units toward a Bachelor of Arts degree at Southern California Seminary.

## EBI accepts CLD and SE credit

Equip Biblical Institute accepts transfer credit from Southern Baptist Contextualized Leadership Development (CLD) and Seminary Extension (SE) into the Diploma and Associate degrees.

## EBI credits are transferable

Although EBI is a religious exempt institution, up to 60 EBI semester units are transferable to the accredited Southern California Seminary Bachelor of Arts (see articulation agreements for details).

## Certificate of Leadership

The Certificate of Leadership is a 1 ½ -year leadership program provided by The Feather River Baptist Association. Certificate involves completing the following requirements:

1. Studying the 12 course textbooks.
2. Attending the 12 courses (10 class hrs. each).
3. Participate in discussions based on the books
4. Creating visual panoramas of the textbooks.
5. Typing action plan based on the textbooks.

The Certificate of Leadership is a developmental certificate that is equal to 120 hours/12 CEU's (Continuing Education Units) as set by The American National Standards Institute. It is specifically designed for those interested in

rapidly enhancing their leadership, teaching, and preaching skills through the local church. The goal is multiplying churches by making "Each Church a School and each Pastor a Teacher."

Students who complete the 1 1/2 year course of studies will receive the Certificate of Leadership and will be eligible to march in the May joint commencement of Southern California Seminary and Equip Biblical Institute; Church Leadership Development.

Costs:

- \$20 Books, or purchase on your
- \$30 Audit class – attend class.
- \$40 Credit for Certificate from EBI of FRBA - CEU's (Continuing Education Units,)
- \$35 One time Registration Fee payable to Feather River Baptist Association (EBI)
- Facility use Fee determined by location.

There is a \$300 graduation fee for the rental of cap and gown and the certificate and cover. Graduates will receive a complimentary meal for two at the Annual Alumni Banquet.

The Certificate of Leadership is excellent preparation for those interested in the Diploma and Associate Programs, but who desire foundational leadership training first.

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## Admission Requirements

1. Submit an application and pastor's endorsement.
2. Submit transcripts of CLD or college courses.

## Graduation requirements

1. **Certificate of Biblical Studies in Leadership:**  
Successfully complete 12 units (10hr. ea.)
2. **Diploma of Biblical Studies in Leadership:**  
Successfully complete 30 units. (28 hr. ea.)
3. **Associate of Biblical Studies in Leadership:**  
Successfully complete 60 units. (28 hr. ea.)
4. **Bachelor of Biblical Studies in Leadership:**  
Successfully complete 130 units. (28 hr. ea.)

Student-leaders are trained in transformational leadership, church planting, essential church, the disciple-making process, relationship building, Bible interpretation, Sunday School growth, expository preaching, church growth, servant leadership, small group coaching, team leadership, conflict resolution, church administration, prayer ministry, biblical marriage, worship, fellowship, community ministry, evangelism, missions, and more.
